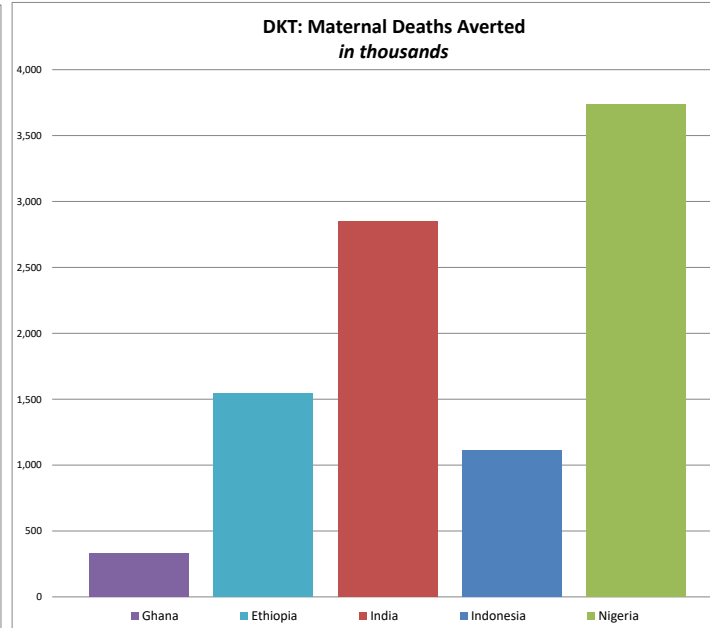
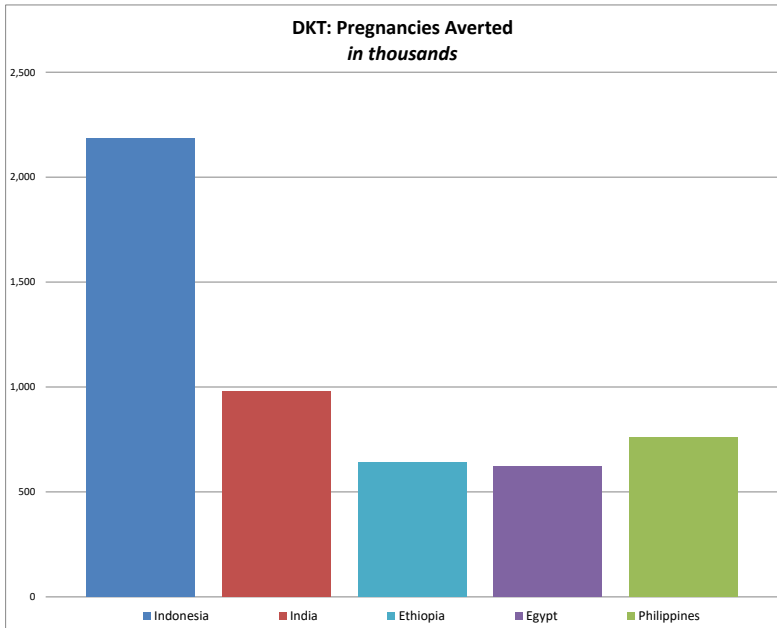

- a. Child deaths averted due to improved health outcomes as a result of birth spacing. Estimates of child deaths averted may be unreliable because there are limited data about the linkages between CPR, birth spacing and child mortality.  
b. The WomenFirst program focuses on abortion care, and therefore has no impact on pregnancies averted and child deaths averted.  
c. Central American and Caribbean countries with relatively small impacts were combined with Mexico. This includes Costa Rica, Panama, Dominican Republic, and El Salvador.  
d. West Africa program includes data from Senegal, Cameroon, Cote D'Ivoire, Gabon, Burkina Faso, Mauritania, Guinea-Bissau, Benin, Guinea, and Mali.



Methodology	
<b>NGO Sales</b>	All sales to NGOs were marked down 50% to better estimate DKT's actual impact.
<b>Public Sector Sales: The 5% Rule</b>	Public sector sales were limited to 5% of overall CYP provision. Impacts of products sold were scaled down to a 5% cap if otherwise exceeded. Countries affected: Egypt, Indonesia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Vietnam.
<b>WomanCare</b>	WomanCare sales to DKT were not included to avoid double counting. Sales to UNFPA and commercial non-DKT partners assumed to facilitate only 5
